

More than 60 faculty members from across the country joined the FDP Program.



HOW TO REACH ALC

BY AIR: Sri Guru Ram Das Ji (IATA: ATQ, ICAO: VIAR) is an international airport is located at a distance of 11 km from the city. The airport at present have a hold of about 200 commercial flights a week, both international (United Kingdom, Singapore, Australia, Canada, UAE, Qatar, Italy etc) and domestic (Delhi, Jammu, Srinagar & Chandigarh among GOLDEN TEMPLE other cities). In December 2009, Amritsar Airport has become the fastest-growing airport in India.



BY TRAIN: Amritsar Junction railway station (station code: ASR) is a railway junction located in Amritsar district in the WAGAH BORDER DURGIANA MANDIR Indian state of Punjab and serves Amritsar. It is the largest and busiest railway station of Punjab. The station is well-connected to a number of Indian cities. Some of the major routes include to the places of Kanpur Central, New Delhi, and Howrah Jn. There are 6 weekly trains connecting Kanpur Central to Amritsar, 3 weekly trains HERITAGE GATE JALLIANWALA BAGH connecting New Delhi to Amritsar, and 2 weekly trains connecting Howrah Jn to Amritsar.

BY ROAD: Amritsar is located on the historic Grand Trunk Road (G.T Road), also known as NH 1 now renumbered as National Highway 3. An expressway by name of Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway at the cost of Rs. 25,000 crore is approved under Bharatmala scheme which will cut the travel time from Amritsar to New Delhi by road from current 8 hours, to 4 hours.
